Median Household Income:

In Stockholm County, where Tumba is located, the median household income has been around 350,000 SEK per year in recent years.

Median Home Value:

The median home value in Tumba can vary, but recent listings show that houses are typically priced between 3,395,000 SEK and 6,495,000 SEK. In the Metropolitan Stockholm area, the median house price is 5,621,000 SEK.

Median Rent/Month:

Average State Property Tax:

In Tumba, as in the rest of Sweden, property owners are liable for municipal property tax. For single-family dwellings, the municipal property tax is calculated based on the property's taxable value. However, it cannot exceed a maximum amount, which for the 2023 income year is 9,287 SEK.

Average Commute Time:

From Tumba to Stockholm city is approximately 26 minutes by train. If you prefer driving it typically takes around 27-46 minutes depending on traffic conditions.

Sales Tax:

In Stockholm, as in the rest of Sweden, the standard sales tax rate (VAT) is 25%. There are also reduced rates for specific goods and services: 12% for food, hotel stays, and certain artworks, and 6% for books, newspapers, and passenger transport.

Income Tax:

In Stockholm, as in the rest of Sweden, the income tax system is progressive and consists of both municipal and state taxes:

Municipal Tax:

This varies depending on the municipality but generally ranges from 29% to 35%.

Sweden Tax:

For high earners, an additional state tax of 20% is applied to income above a certain threshold.

For example, if you earn above approximately 540,700 SEK per year, you will pay the additional state tax

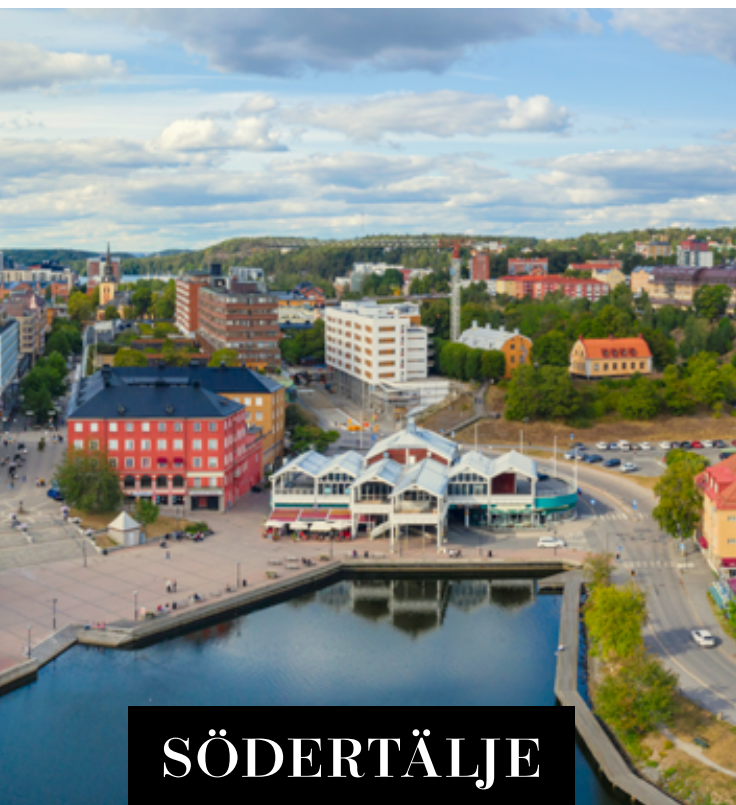

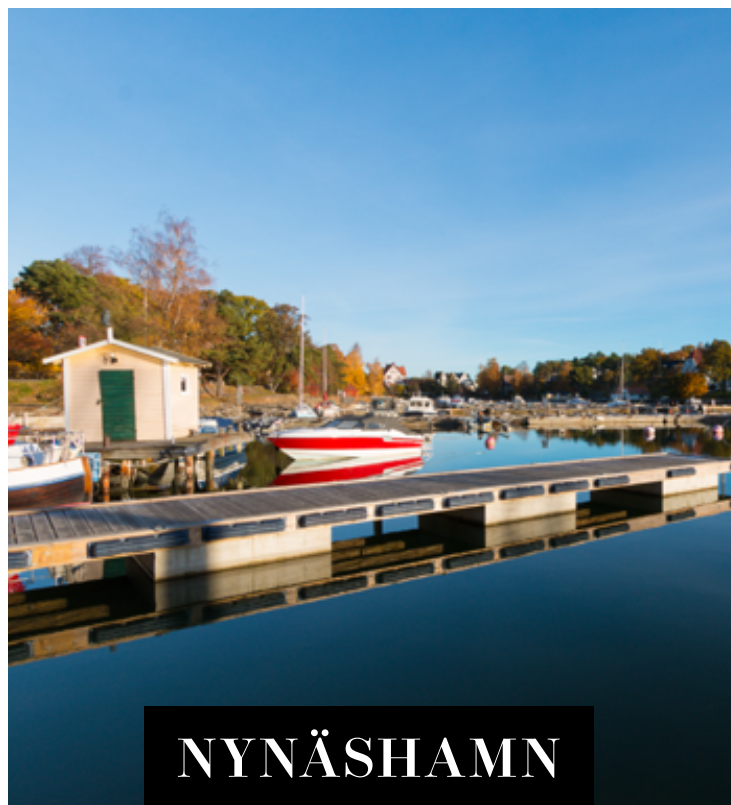

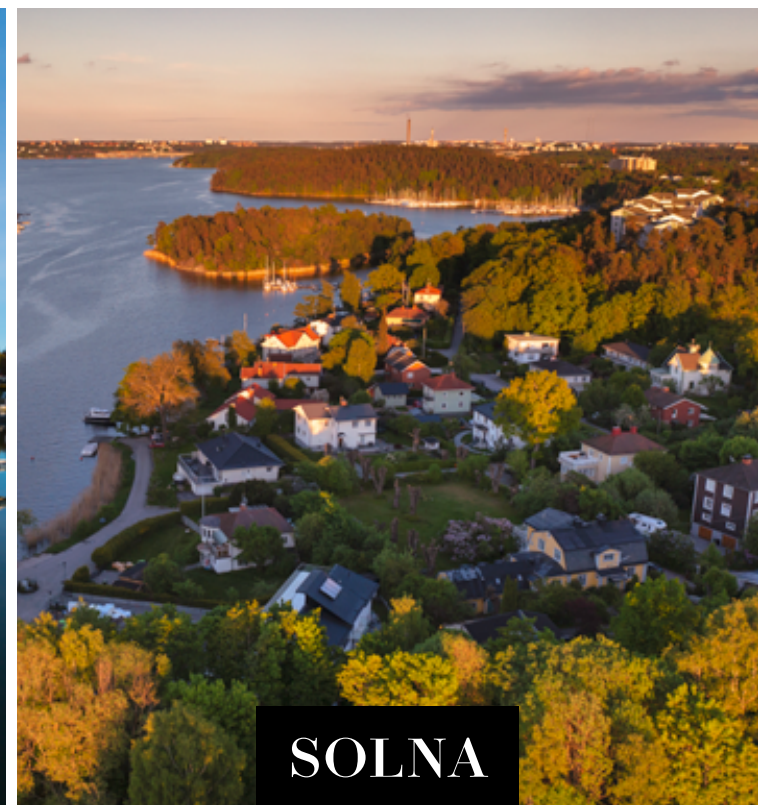

PRESCHOOLS AND KINDERGARTENS

Förskolor: These are preschools for children aged 1-5 years. They focus on play-based learning and social development.

BUS, TAXI, TRAIN, AND RIDE SHARE SERVICES

To travel to and from Tumba using public transportation, you can take the Stockholm commuter trains (Pendeltåg), which connect Tumba to various parts of Stockholm County. The journey to Stockholm City takes about 25 minutes, and several bus routes also serve Tumba, providing additional connections

To commute to and from Tumba by taxi, you have several options. Services like Uber and Bolt are available and can be booked via their respective apps. Additionally, Färdtjänst provides specialized taxi services for individuals with disabilities or special needs. You can also use local taxi companies such as Botkyrka Taxi and Taxi Kuri

TRANSPORTATION TO THE AIRPORT

1. Train: Direct Train: There is a direct train from Tumba station to Arlanda Centralstation, this journey takes about 1 hour. You can also take the train (pendeltåg) from Tumba Station to Stockholm City Station, then transfer to a Expressstrains heading to Arlanda. This route takes approximately 49 minutes. www.arlandaexpress.se www.sl.se

2. Bus: Use Flygbussarna or FlixBus to reach Stockholm City, then switch to a commuter train to Tumba. This option takes around 1 hour and 20 minutes. www.flygbussarna.se

3. Taxi: Direct taxi services like Uber, Bolt, or local companies such as Botkyrka Taxi and Taxi Kurir can take you directly from Arlanda to Tumba in about 55 minutes.

4. Car: Driving via the E4 highway, the trip takes approximately 40-55 minutes depending on traffic
